VILLAGE COUNCIL OF NORTH FAIRFIELD, OHIO RESOLUTION NO. 20<u>20</u>-R-<u>04</u>

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SERVICES OF WATER SUPERINTENDENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village owns and operates a public water system provided by RC 715.08; and

WHEREAS, the Village would like to enter into an agreement for the services of a water superintendent.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT <u>RESOLVED</u> BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF <u>NORTH FAIRFIELD</u>, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

- <u>SECTION 1</u>. That Village Council hereby determines it is necessary to contract for the services of a water superintendent.
- <u>SECTION 2</u>. <u>AUTHORIZE AGREEMENT</u>. That the Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract/agreement <u>ATTACHED HERETO</u> and incorporated herein by reference, with <u>CLINT MINNEAR</u> to provide services of water superintendent.
- <u>SECTION 3</u>. <u>TERM</u>. That the term of the contract/agreement authorized herein shall begin <u>RETROACTIVELY</u> on <u>April 1, 2020</u> and terminate <u>December 31, 2020</u> and shall <u>automatically renew annually unless terminated by either party</u>.
- <u>SECTION 4.</u> <u>SCHEDULE OF PAYMENT.</u> That Council hereby authorizes a monthly retainer of <u>Five Hundred Fifty</u> Dollars (\$<u>550.00</u>) along with an additional hourly rate of <u>One Hundred Fifty</u> Dollars (\$<u>150.00</u>) per hour "back hoe" equipment fee.
- <u>SECTION 5</u>. That any and all previous contracts and agreements for water superintendent services are hereby terminated.
- SECTION 6. <u>DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS</u>. That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days. [R.C. 731.17(A)(2)]
- SECTION 7. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this Ordinance/Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the

immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s): The immediate effectiveness is necessary to assure uninterrupted service.				
SECTION 8. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution/Ordinance were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
